Seafarms Group Limited subsidiary, CO2 Australia Limited, awarded major Commonwealth government contracts under the 20 Million Trees Program and Emissions Reduction Fund

Seafarms Group Limited (ASX: SFG) is pleased to advise that its environmental services subsidiary, CO2 Australia Limited (CO2 Australia), has secured three significant new contracts with the Commonwealth government.

Environment Minister, Mr Greg Hunt, announced today CO2 Australia has been appointed as a large-scale provider to the Commonwealth's 20 Million Trees Program (the **Program**), a major funding initiative designed to protect and restore the environment and make agriculture more sustainable and productive. In total, the Commonwealth has committed \$50 million to the 20 Million Trees Program to fund the planting of 20 million trees by year 2020.

CO2 Australia is one of three large-scale providers appointed to deliver revegetation programs under the Program. CO2 Australia has a substantial portfolio of developed projects that it anticipates will be taken up under this contract, with delivery expected to take place across at least three Australian states. Early-stage works will commence from May 2015.

CO2 Australia has also been successful in securing the two Carbon Abatement Contracts it bid for through the Commonwealth's recent Emissions Reduction Fund auction. Under these contracts, Australian Carbon Credit Units (ACCUs) will be supplied to the Commonwealth over a 10 year contract period, providing a robust forward sales pipeline.

The ACCUs will be generated from two reforestation projects under CO2 Australia's management, which have been registered with the Clean Energy Regulator and are already producing ACCUs. The Commonwealth government has made recent announcements that provide further detail on the auction process and outcomes.

The securing of this series of contracts supports CO2 Australia's strategy of continued expansion of its service offerings into the environmental, consulting and land management services areas.
